General Rules

General Responsibilities:

- Skaters must sign in and pay any ice fees to the club cashier on duty BEFORE going on the ice.
- Skaters are not to bring gum, candy, food or breakable item (glass bottles) onto the ice.
- Skaters must clean up after themselves when sessions are over. This includes tissues, water bottles, CD's, clothing, etc.

Safety & Etiquette

- Members shall be required to comply with the Skaters Code of Conduct posted at the facilities and Assumption of Risk Agreement.
- Jumps are to be performed at the ends of the rink, spins at the center.
- Skaters who are practicing their program or who are in lesson have the right of way.
- Skaters practicing their program MUST wear the orange vests or sash provided by the music monitors.
- Skaters should refrain from interfering with a lesson by skating in between a skater and their coach
- All skaters and professionals must wear appropriate clothing. Skates must be worn by everyone on the ice.
- Skaters should not sit or lay on the ice. If you fall, get up quickly.
- Skaters should not dig holes in the ice.
- Priority for right of way is as follows:
 - Skater having music played
 - Skater having a lesson
 - Other Skaters
- New or less experienced skaters should not hover too close to an advanced skater if they are spinning. Advanced skaters can change their body position in a spin very quickly and to avoid collision, please make sure you're at least 10 feet away.
- Advanced skaters are expected to exhibit patience toward newer beginner members of the club. Remember, you were an inexperienced skater once, and it takes time for our future generation to advance to the point where they are completely comfortable skating with all levels of skaters.

Program Music

- All skaters wishing to have their program music played must submit a CD to the music monitor. As a convenience, the club may have music of members on file, but the responsibility is the skater's to make sure they have their music on hand.
- Music will be played in the order it is received.
- The skater whose music is being played MUST wear an orange vest or sash to alert other skaters to keep out of the way.
- Professionals may request that a skater's music be played twice during a skater's lesson. If the session is not crowded, the music monitor may play the music more than twice.

Waiver and Release, Assumption of Risk and Parental Consent and Indemnity Agreement

In consideration of my minor child being permitted to participate in any way in the **Figure Skating Club of Hunterdon** sponsored Activities ("Activity"), I agree:

1. I understand the nature of **U.S. Figure Skating Club of Hunterdon** activities and the Minor's Experience and capabilities and believe the Minor to be qualified to participate in such Activity. I further acknowledge that I and the Minor are aware the activity will be conducted in facilities open to the public during the Activity. I further agree and warrant and will instruct the Minor that if at any time the Minor believes conditions to be unsafe, he/she will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.

2. I FULLY UNDERSTAND that: (a) **Figure Skating Club of Hunterdon** Activities involve risks and dangers of **SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH** ("Risks"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by the Minor's own actions, or inaction's, the actions or inaction's of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be other risks and social and economic losses either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I **FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES** incurred as a result of the Minor's Participation in the Activity.

3. I HEREBY RELEASE, DISCHARGE, COVENANT NOT TO SUE, AND AGREE TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the **Figure Skating Club of Hunterdon**, their respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place (each considered one of the "Releasees" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on the minor's account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "Releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations and further agree that if, despite this release, I, the minor, or anyone on the Minor's behalf makes a claim against any of the Releasees named above, I **WILL INDEMNIFY, SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS EACH OF THE RELEASEES FROM ANY LITIGATION EXPENSES, ATTORNEY FEES, LOSS LIABILITY, DAMAGE OR COST ANY MAY INCUR AS THE RESULT OF ANY SUCH CLAIM.**

4. **MEDICAL RELEASE:** I hereby release Figure Skating Club of Hunterdon from any claim whatsoever which may arise as a result of any first aid, treatment, or services or assistance provided to my child in connection with any injury that arises from activities at FSCOH. **A)** I take full responsibility for my child's welfare and safety on at FSCOH activities. **B)** I hereby give permission for emergency medical treatment to be administered as deemed appropriate.

5. **INSURANCE:** YOU ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE YOUR OWN HEALTH INSURANCE. You should understand that FSCOH does not carry insurance to cover injuries and losses that may befall you.

I HAVE READ THIS AGREEMENT, FULLY UNDERSTAND IT'S TERMS, UNDERSTAND THAT I AND THE MINOR HAVE GIVEN UP SUBSTANTIAL RIGHTS BY SIGNING IT AND HAVE SIGNED IT FREELY AND WITHOUT ANY INDUCEMENT OR ASSURANCE OF ANY NATURE AND INTEND IT TO BE A COMPLETE AND UNCONDITIONAL RELEASE OF ALL LIABILITY TO THE GREATEST EXTENT ALLOWED BY LAW AND AGREE THAT IF ANY PORTION OF THIS AGREEMENT IS HELD TO BE INVALID THAT THE BALANCE, NOTWITHSTANDING, SHALL CONTINUE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
